

### Getting Dressed – Helping with putting on the right shoe.

Draw half of a circle in each of your child's shoe. Explain that putting the shoes on the right feet will make a full circle. Show this to your child and then show them how it doesn't work if the shoes are on the wrong feet.

Velcro fastenings will help your child to be independent until they learn to fasten laces or buckles.

Don't forget to put your child's name in both shoes. This will help the teacher when your child has lost their shoes when they are getting changed. They may forget what their shoe looks like or several other students may have the same shoe!
