

## EYPP Provision for Flatts Nursery School 2018-2019

Allocation for financial year 2018-19

- Summer Term 2018 £1812
- Autumn Term 2018 £1558
- Spring Term 2019 £1717

Total Funding - £5087

At Flatts each term once the children who attract this premium have been identified the funding is used to provide extra staffing to work closely in small groups or on a 1:1 basis with the children concerned focussed on Maths and Literacy.

The steps we follow to ensure we are using the funding efficiently are as follows

1. Identify the needs of eligible children, using professional judgement, observations, data and information from outside agencies or parents
2. Identify possible trends amongst eligible children, to work with groups of children on a similar target
3. Measure the impact to feed into the next cycle.

Idea for EYPP funding	Costings	Monitoring of impact
Summer Term 2018 (19 eligible children)	10 hours per week = £150.30 x 12 = £1803.60	Children in this group made good progress from their starting points in the specific areas of Maths and Literacy
Autumn Term 2018 (14 eligible children)	7.5 hours per week = £112.73 x 14 = £1578.22	
Spring Term 2019 (18 eligible children)	9.5 hours per week = £142.79 x 12 = £1713.48

Considerations for 2019-2020 – Tracking systems to be monitored closely every 6 weeks to ensure children are making progress and evaluate approach. Provision map to identify PP areas of need, in addition to Literacy and Maths.
