- 3. TO IMPROVE PARENT PARTNERSHIPS THROUGH STRONG TRANSITIONS, MILESTONE MEETINGS, IMPLEMENTING PARENT WORKSHOPS, STAY AND PLAY SESSIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORM
- 4. TO IMPROVE LITERACY OUTCOMES, PARTICULARLY READING THROUGH A STRONG READING OFFER FOR CHILDREN AND IMPLEMENTING HELICOPTER STORIES
- 5. TO REMOVE BARRIERS AND IMPROVE OUTDOOR PROVISION TO ENABLE CHILDREN TO ENGAGE WITH THE WORLD AND OFFER OPPORTUNITIES FOR BOTH FINE AND GROSS MOTOR SKILLS
