At Flatts we currently have a 3-year pupil premium strategy. This is year 2 of the strategy. There are five areas which have been identified to improve the outcomes of children who attract EYPP.

1. **TO IMPROVE OUTCOMES FOR CHILDREN IN COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE FOR CHILDREN THROUGH INCREASING STAFF KNOWLEDGE AND TEACHING SKILLS**
2. **TO IMPROVE OUTCOMES FOR CHILDREN IN MATH'S FOR CHILDREN THROUGH INCREASING STAFF KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERTISE AND IMPROVING THE ENVIRONMENT**
3. **TO IMPROVE PARENT PARTNERSHIPS THROUGH STRONG TRANSITIONS, MILESTONE MEETINGS, IMPLEMENTING PARENT WORKSHOPS, STAY AND PLAY SESSIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORM**
4. **TO IMPROVE LITERACY OUTCOMES, PARTICULARLY READING THROUGH A STRONG READING OFFER FOR CHILDREN AND IMPLEMENTING HELICOPTER STORIES**
5. **TO REMOVE BARRIERS AND IMPROVE OUTDOOR PROVISION TO ENABLE CHILDREN TO ENGAGE WITH THE WORLD AND OFFER OPPORTUNITIES FOR BOTH FINE AND GROSS MOTOR SKILLS**
